# Handprint Bouquet

#### You will need:

Paint

Ribbon

Paper

- Glue
- Paintbrush
- · Shallow trays or paper trays



First, pour a little paint onto a paper plate or shallow tray. Next, gently press your hand into one colour of paint and then press onto the paper.



Repeat 2 or 3 more times, overlapping the handprints a little. You could use both hands to try different colours. Don't forget to wash your hands!



Then, paint some long green lines onto the base of each handprint to be stems for the flowers and leave to dry.



Next, dip a finger into some yellow or orange paint and create some fingerprints in the middle of each palm print to create the middle of each flower. Leave it to dry again.



Once all the paint is dry you can add a ribbon to your bouquet! Ask an adult to help you to tie a bow into the ribbon and stick it onto the stems of the bouquet. You could also write a message on your picture to show who your handprint bouquet is for!





# Handprint Bouquet
