Spelling: Each day, children are expected to look at the key stage 2 spelling list (some children will still need to practise the year 3 and 4 spelling list). Remember these are key words to practise and learn how to spell.

It's also good to practise spelling patterns. Choose a word from the KS2 list and investigate what other words are spelt in a similar way. For example: Equipment – this is made up using the prefix 'equip'. What other words can you find and learn that use this prefix? 'ment' is also a suffix. What other words can you investigate and learn, which use the 'ment' ending?
