Outdoor Learning	<ul> <li>Getting the garden ready for Spring/growing - weeding, planting seeds for veg, preparing beds and containers</li> <li>Dry out tomato seeds from a tomato and planting inside</li> <li>Create a teddy bears picnic outside – sharing/halving plastic food equally.</li> <li>Bug hunting (signs of spring – weather warming up ad animals waking up)</li> <li>Subtraction game: create a target game using hoops (planet) with balls/bean bags as asteroids. Make it a subtraction game by starting 20 points – the first person to 0 wins!</li> <li>Create a game using bats, ball, cones or hoops – crate your own rules and then teach it to a friend/family member</li> </ul>			<ul> <li>2D/3D shape walk</li> <li>Wet sand – make alien party food! Introduce writing equipment into play</li> <li>Alien dances – ribbons, music, instruments</li> <li>Create a large balance scales using buckets and hanger</li> <li>Create an egg Hunt – link to positional language or create a map to go with egg hunt</li> <li>Egg rolling (link to length) – roll a boiled egg down the hill. How far does it roll? Who's egg can roll the furthest?
